NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR DISCUSSION OF POSSIBLE STATE CDBG-CV APPLICATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of Elko will conduct a public hearing on Thursday October 29, 2020 at 5:15pm in Suite 102 of the Nannini Administration Building located at 540 Court Street, Elko, Nevada in order to discuss possible applications for funding under the State Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) Program and to solicit citizen input on possible activities to be included in the application. It is estimated that approximately \$819,000 will be available in total for this second round of funding.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES UNDER THE ABOVE ALLOCATION CONSIST OF: ACTIVITIES THAT PREVENT, PREPARE AND RESPOND TO THE SPREAD OF INFECTIOUS DISEASES SUCH AS THE CORONAVIRUS; BUILDINGS AND IMPROVEMENTS, ASSISTANCE TO BUSINESS, PROVISION OF NEW OR QUANTIFIABLY INCREASED PUBLIC SERVICES, PLANNING, CAPACITY BUILDING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.

The purpose of this public hearing is to provide information about the CDBG-CV program, past projects that have been funded in the County of Elko, how to apply, eligibility requirements, how and where funds can be used, and to give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known regarding what types of eligible activities the County of Elko should apply for under the State CDBG-CV program.
