

**A RESOLUTION SETTING THE WATER RATES
FOR THE JARBIDGE WATER SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, Title 9, Chapter 3, Section 16 of the ordinance requires water rates and charges for the Jarbidge Water System be set by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners, and;

WHEREAS, Title 9, Chapter 3, Section 7 of the ordinance provides for a cash deposit for establishment of credit for the Jarbidge Water System to be set by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners, and;

WHEREAS, Title 9, Chapter 3, Section 15(G) of the ordinance requires re-connection charges for the Jarbidge Water System be set by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the water rates for the Jarbidge Water District are as follows, effective October 1, 2019 and July 1, 2020:

The monthly rates for water service are as follows:

Residential Use Per Connection:			
February 1, 2020	Monthly		\$62.00
Commercial Use Per Connection:			
February 1, 2020	Monthly		\$105.10

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the re-connection charges for the Jarbidge Water District are as follows:

The re-connection charge for discontinued service or voluntary disconnection as a result of nonpayment of bills or noncompliance with the provisions of Title 9, Chapter 3 of Elko County Code (Jarbidge Water System) shall be one year's full service price at the current annual rate.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that a cash deposit for the establishment credit for the Jarbidge Water District pursuant to County Code Title 9, Chapter 3, Section 7 be set as follows:

The cash deposit required to establish credit shall be equal to the monthly rate times 2. This deposit shall be returned after 12 months of service in which the customer has promptly paid all water bills.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the special circumstance (i.e. temporary projects, man camps, etc.) fees for the Jarbidge Water District are as follows:
